PARTICIPATION: Teen Ambassador applicants must be 14 to 18 years old, privately home educating, and current ICHE members. Ambassadors will be representing only private home education to our legislators. Congressional Award Medal recipients are encouraged to apply, due to the high legislative interest in this program. Ambassadors help with setup at 8:00 a.m., deliver whole pies to officials, escort legislators around displays, and assist with cleanup after 2:00 p.m.

ORIENTATION: A *required* orientation will be held in January to prepare Ambassadors for their duties and acquaint them with Capitol protocols. An additional briefing will be held on Legislative Day. Wear Legislative Day attire to orientation training and to Legislative Day. If you have earned your Congressional Award Medals, please wear them on Legislative Day and bring your completed Congressional Award Record Books to display.

PROTOCOLS: Appropriate dress is business attire in keeping with the formality of the legislature, and Congressional Award medals if earned. Females: dresses with sleeves, dress lengths at or below the knees, and hosiery. No pants or leggings. Males: dark slacks, collared dress shirts, and ties. No tennis shoes, jeans or hats.
