QUALIFICATION

Testing is open to all privately home educated students who are taught three or more of the following academic subjects at home: math, language, reading, science, and social studies. Students enrolled in online charter schools, such as Idaho Virtual Academy (K12) or IDEA, are included in the state public school scores and do not qualify for ICHE testing.

TEST CONTENT *NEW! Updated Test Version*

Iowa Tests of Basic Skills (ITBS) grades 3-9:

Vocabulary, reading, spelling, capitalization, usage, punctuation, math (concepts, problem solving, data interpretation, estimation, and computation), social studies, science, reference materials (maps, diagrams, and sources of information).

Iowa Tests of Educational Development (ITED) grades 9-12:

Vocabulary, language, reading, spelling, math, computation, social studies, science, reference materials (maps, diagrams and sources of information).

Test Scope and Sequence: go to "Testing" at iche-idaho.org. **Ninth graders will choose either ITBS or ITED.**

STATISTICS

In addition to our group composite statistics, comparisons are offered with public school scores, as well as data based upon the number of years of home education. Students who have been home educated three or more years typically score 15 to 20 points higher than those home educated for one year or less.
