**PARTICIPATION:** The hundreds of homemade pies served at Legislative Day make this the most popular event at the Capitol during the legislative session. It is our goal to not only serve the officials and staff who attend, but to give whole pies to each legislative and executive office in the Capitol Mall. To succeed in this enormous endeavor, we need your help.

**PIES:** All pies must be home baked to be served. Sign up to bake two or more pies in disposable tins which cannot be returned. Fruit or nut pies are preferred, but cream pie, if very firm, will stand up. Sugar-free and gluten-free are also greatly appreciated by our legislators on special diets, but must be clearly labeled with the ingredients, your name, and phone number in the event of dietary questions.

Legislators often ask for the recipe of a pie served, and the family and district that provided it. Please label all pies with the type of pie, your name, and legislative district, along with a copy of the recipe, if possible. In 2006, we gifted each legislator with a recipe book of our Legislative Day pie recipes. The legislators would delight in having your recipes added to the collection.

**DELIVERY:** Between 8:15 and 9:30 a.m. deliver pies on W. Jefferson Street (one way street directly in front of the Capitol Building) to Teen Ambassadors or Boy Scouts who will be receiving your pies from your car; there is no need to park. If it will be difficult for you to take your pies downtown the morning of Legislative Day, drop off points in West Boise, Mid-Boise, and Nampa will be available on Tuesday, February 1<sup>st</sup>.
